This is a part-time role (24 hours per week) and can be remote, with occasional in-person meetings as required.

Working within a small communications team, you will play a key role in producing video content that communicates the life, mission and voice of the Catholic Church in Scotland.

### Key Responsibilities

- Edit high-quality video content for social media, web and digital platforms
- Produce both short-form and long-form content, including interviews, features and campaign videos
- Support editing for livestream and broadcast outputs
- Assist with occasional live broadcasting, which may require travel to events and locations as needed
- Add graphics, captions, music and basic motion elements where appropriate
- Manage video assets, organise files and maintain an efficient workflow
- Work to deadlines and respond to briefs from the Director of Communications

- Experience producing content for social media and digital platforms
- Confident using editing software to create high-quality outputs
- Good understanding of visual style and audience engagement
